Northwest Florida Championship Rodeo Pageant Rules and Regulations

All Northwest Florida Championship Rodeo Pageant Title Holders:

- During Rodeo Weekend (Thursday, October 4th – Saturday, October 6th) title holders must represent the Northwest Florida Championship Rodeo. If title holder holds another title, that title sash, crown or title name can not be used for the three days.
- Are asked to attend the Bonifay Kiwanis Club Rodeo BBQ Luncheon on Wednesday, October 3rd at noon. For location contact the Bonifay Kiwanis Club Office at (850) 547-5363.
- Are asked to contact Jon Sims with Sims Signs at (850) 373-8086 to purchase their name for the magnetic signs. The Bonifay Kiwanis Club Parade Committee owns the Title Magnets.
- Will be provided a Dodge truck to ride through the Parade of Rodeo Royalty each night of the rodeo. Miss, Jr. Miss, and Young will be on the lead truck with all others on board the second truck. The trucks will be driven by representatives from the US Army. After Thursday and Friday Night's Parade of Royalty, place the Title and Your Name Magnets inside the first Dodge Truck. The magnets will be locked inside the truck to be taken to the Bonifay Elementary School for Friday and Saturday's Rodeo Parade. You may take your Name Magnets home on Saturday Night, but make sure Holly Holland receives the Title Magnets.
- Will receive their own Dodge truck to ride through the NWFC Rodeo Parades sponsored by Performance Realty on Friday, October 5th and Saturday, October 6th. You will need to arrive no later than 1:00 PM both days. A parent or a legal guardian will need to drive you during the parades and will be required to provide a copy of their valid driver's license and proof of insurance. Only NWFC Rodeo Queens and Kings are allowed to ride in the back of the Dodge truck. Tiny Miss, Littlest Miss and Littlest King must have an adult with them in the back of the Dodge Truck. No other children are allowed to ride in the back of the Dodge Truck and only one other person may ride in the cab of the Dodge truck with the driver. After the parades are over, place the Title and Your Name Magnets inside the Miss NWFC Rodeo Dodge Truck. The magnets will be locked inside the truck to be taken to Memorial Field. Parents, Queens, Kings, and all other passengers are responsible to get back to their vehicles after the parade has ended.
- Will be provided a ½ a case of Mardi Gras Beads to throw out during each NWFC Rodeo Parades by the Bonifay Kiwanis Club Rodeo Parade Committee. Addition case may be purchased through the Bonifay Kiwanis Club by calling (850) 547-5363.

Miss Northwest Florida Championship Rodeo Queen's Responsibilities:

- Are to speak on several "live television" morning and noon shows throughout the area. She will be visiting these shows with Bonifay Kiwanis Club Rodeo Chairman Herb Peel and Bonifay Kiwanis Club Secretary Holly Holland.
- Are to speak on several "live radiobroadcast" throughout the area. She will be visiting these radio stations with Bonifay Kiwanis Club Rodeo Chairman Herb Peel and Bonifay Kiwanis Club Secretary Holly Holland.
- Is to assist in the throwing out of NWFC Rodeo Sponsorship Giveaways during Intermission each night of the NWFC Rodeo.
- Is to open the five o'clock news broadcast of several news stations in the area before the NWFC

Rodeo begins as well as do live interviews with several radio stations after the rodeo parades.
